

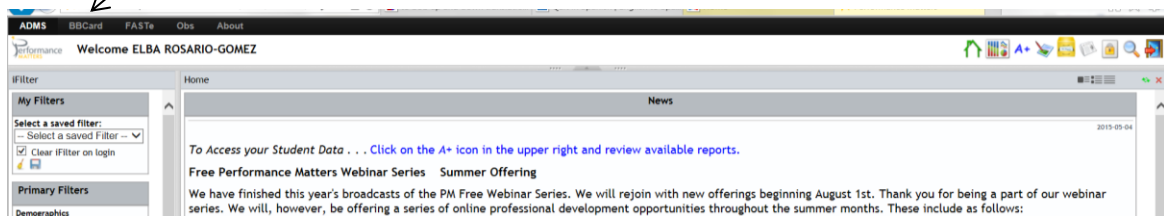
ACCESS DATA for ELs

The English Learner's ACCESS scores can provide you with information regarding the student's language proficiency. There is scoring for the four language domains (Listening, Speaking, Reading and Writing) and an overall score known as a CPL (Composite Proficiency Level).

In order to ACCESS the scores, you can reach out to your ESL support staff or retrieve the data from Performance Matters.


Accessing ACCESS Scores from Performance Matters

- 1) Go to www.performancematters.com and log in.
- 2) Click on the BBCard on the top left corner.



Clicking on this tab will allow you to export the data onto Excel.

- 3) Click on the box on the right to limit your search. (Suggested by "grade" and "LEP")
- 4) Click on the left side where it says "ACCESS for ELL".
- 5) You can select from the four domains and/or the Composite score (CPL). Make sure you are selecting the correct year.
- 6) As you select, each score will appear on the right side.
