LINGT.com is a website that will allow teachers to collect speech samples

Kids can record their voices

They can watch a video and write about it

This website can be used to build IPAs.

These speech samples are then sent to the teacher's page where he/she post the assignments for the students.

Kids go into lingt.com and look at the assignment posted under their class period

Students can take the assessment on ipads or chrome books or laptops or cell phones.

Raquel uses google classroom and they click on the link for **lingt.com**

She can give verbal feedback, she doesn't have to write anything!

Kids will listen to her recorded feedback.

Intermediate mid is equal to a 5 on the AP test
