Agreement
"I agree with because"
> "I like what said because"
"I agree with; but on the other hand,"
Disagreement
"I disagree with because"
"I'm not sure I agree with what said because"
> "I can see that; however, I disagree with (or can't see)"
Clarifications
"Could you please repeat that for me?"
Paraphrase what you heard and ask, "Could you explain a bit more, please?"
"I'm not sure I understood you when you said Could you say more about that?"
"What's your evidence?"
"How does that support our work with?"
Confirmation
> "I think ."
<ul><li>"I think"</li><li>I believe"</li></ul>
Confusion
"I don't understand ."
<ul><li>"I don't understand"</li><li>I am confused about"</li></ul>
Extension
$\succ$ "I was thinking about what said, and I was wondering what if"
"This makes me think"
> "I want to know more about"
> "Now I am wondering"
"Can you tell me more about"
