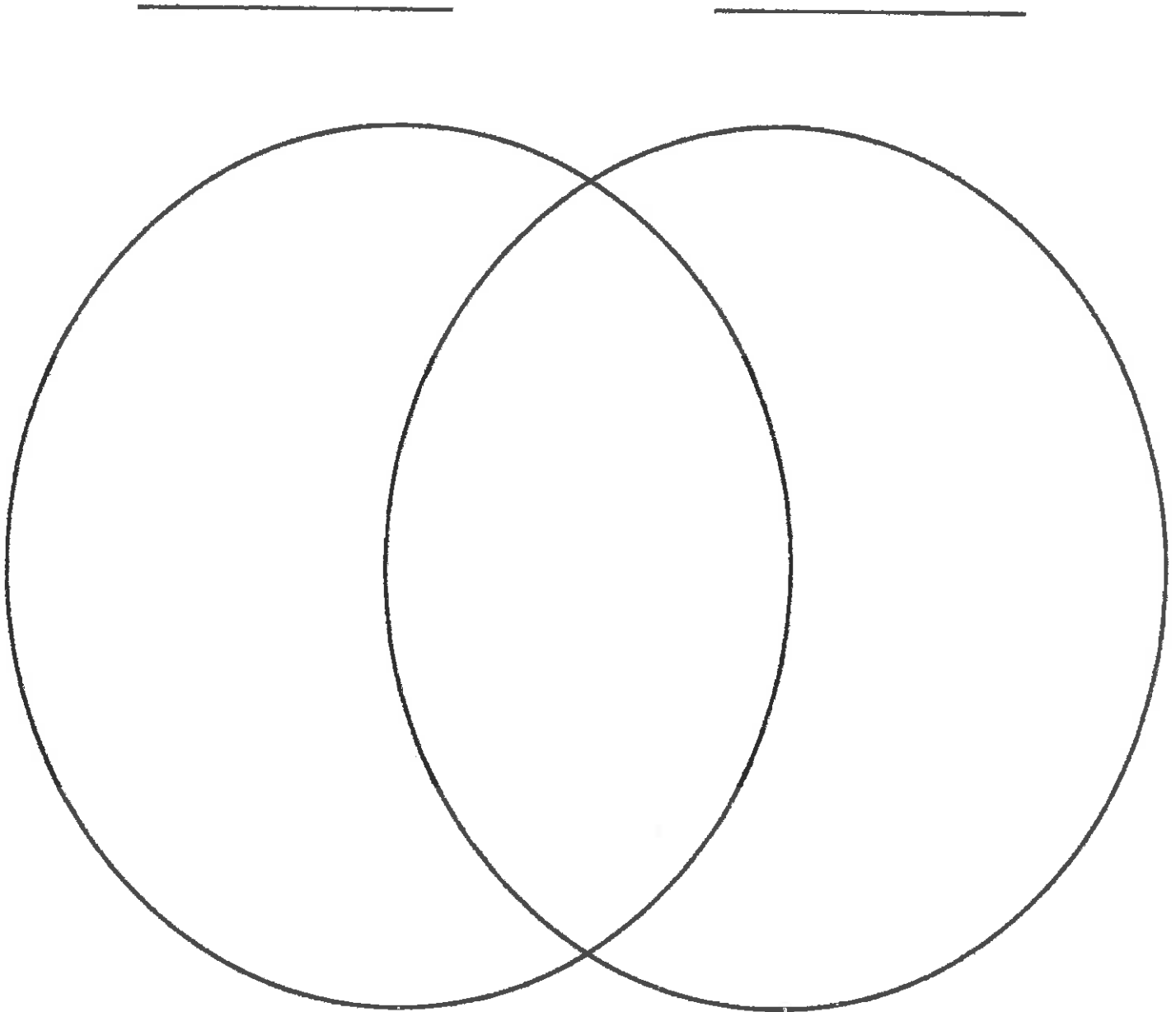
Complex Venn Diagram-Comparing Three Texts

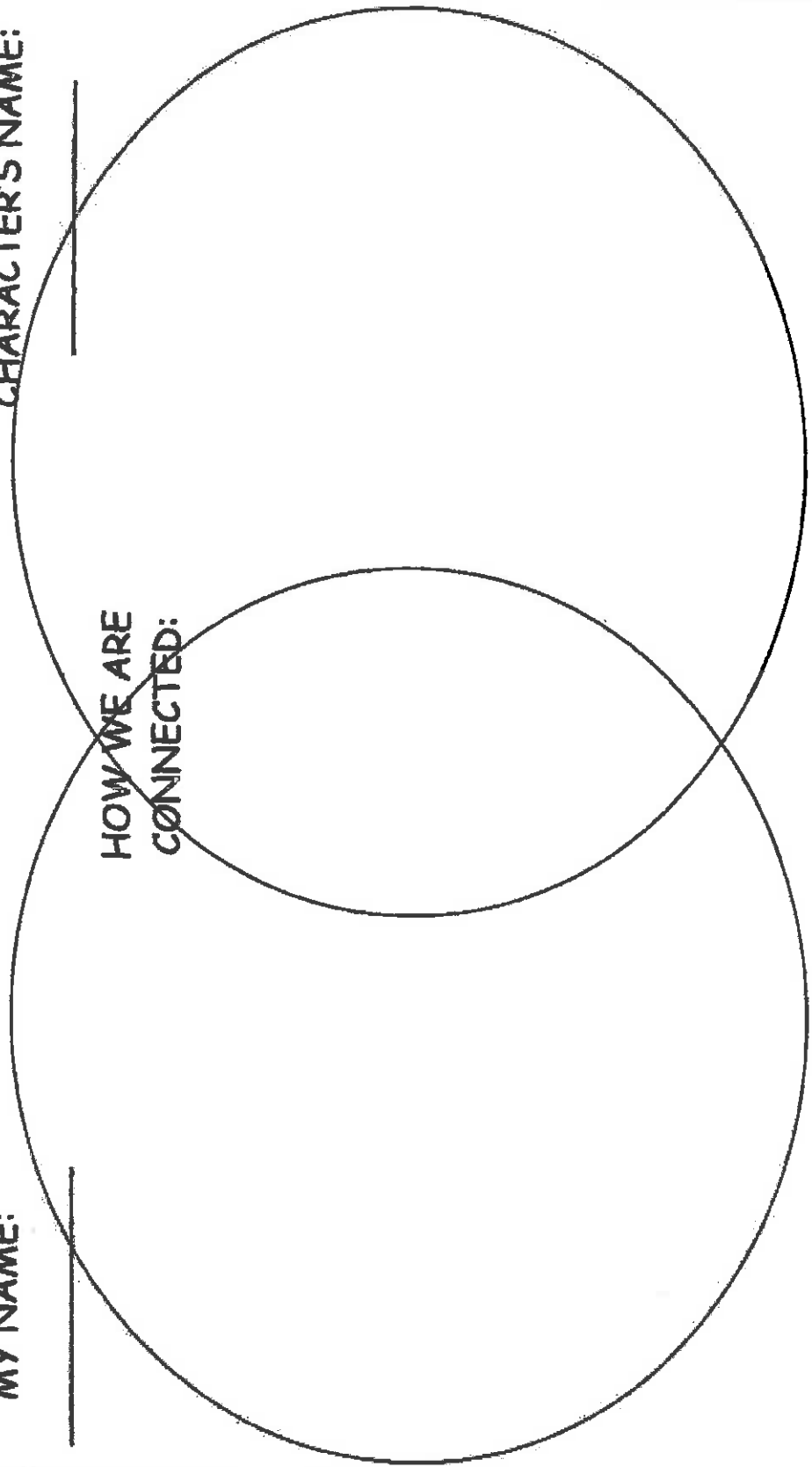
