As many of you know, Governor Murphy has issued an executive order for all nonessential workers to stay at home. I want to make sure you know that we will continue distributing student meals tomorrow at 10 a.m. at 14 sites throughout Paterson. There are provisions in the governor's executive order that designate the Paterson Public Schools' student meal distribution program as an essential service and allow the district to continue providing meals to students while the executive order is in effect.
