This is Paterson Superintendent of Schools Eileen Shafer with a message for all parents and guardians of Paterson Public Schools students.

I want to remind you that on Monday, March 30th, the district will be distributing student meals twice a week, on Mondays and Wednesdays.

On Monday, from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m., parents and guardians will be able to pick up enough student meals for their children to last two days...Monday and Tuesday.

Then, on Wednesday, parents and guardians will be able to pick up enough student meals for their children to last three days...Wednesday, Thursday and Friday.

xsAlso, on Monday, March 30th, a new roster of meal distribution sites will go into effect.
