This is a message from Paterson Public Schools with an important message for all parents and guardians of district students.

We want to remind you that tomorrow, Monday, March 30th, the district will be distributing student meals twice a week, on Mondays and Wednesdays.

Tomorrow, from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m., parents and guardians will be able to pick up enough student meals for their children to last two days...Monday and Tuesday.

Then, on Wednesday, parents and guardians will be able to pick up enough student meals for their children to last three days...Wednesday, Thursday and Friday.

Also, tomorrow Monday, March 30th, a new roster of student meal distribution sites will go into effect. The new roster includes Public School No. 18 at 51 East 18th Street as one of the student meal distribution sites instead of the Paterson Riverside Veterans Center.
