PATERSON SCHOOL BOARD CANDIDACY INFORMATION AVAILABLE AT THE PASSAIC COUNTY CLERK'S OFFICE

The election for members of the Paterson Board of Education will be held on Tuesday, November 7, 2017.

The school election will be held to fill three (3) three-year seats on the Board of Education. The deadline for filing nominating petitions with the Passaic County Clerk's Office to have your name placed on the ballot for the Paterson Board of Education is 4:00 p.m., Monday, July 31, 2017.

Candidates filing a nominating petition for Board membership must meet the following qualifications:

- He/she is citizen of the United States of America.
- He/she must be at least eighteen (18) years of age to qualify for office.
- He/she must be able to read and write.
- He/she has been a resident of the municipality from which he/she is to be elected for at least one year preceding the date of the election.
- He/she is not disqualified as a voter pursuant to R.S. 19:4-1.
- He/she is not disqualified from membership for the conviction of crimes pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:12-1
- He/she is a registered voter in the district.
