## **NEW STUDENT HOME INSTRUCTION PACKETS ARE NOW AVAILABLE FOR DOWNLOAD ON THE DISTRICT WEBSITE**

PATERSON – District officials today announced that the new student home instruction packets are now available for download on the district website.

“Simply visit [paterson.k12.nj.us](http://paterson.k12.nj.us) and click on the COVID-19 quick link, then click on the tab that says, ‘Downloadable Student Home Instruction Packets,’” said Superintendent of Schools Eileen Shafer in an automated phone message to parents. “You will find a series of links that will lead you to the packets your child needs. The packets are pdfs that can be downloaded and printed out.”

Shafer reminded parents that hard copies of the packets will also be distributed on Monday, March 30th, Tuesday, March 31st, and Wednesday, April 1st from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. at 23 distribution sites throughout the City of Paterson.

Since district schools have been closed beginning on March 17th, all Paterson Public Schools have been sanitized.

Shafer also reminded parents that they can find out which sites will be distributing packets for each school by checking notices posted on the COVID-19 page on the district’s website, the district’s Facebook page, and the district’s Instagram account.

If a smartphone is a family’s only internet access, or if a family does not have a printer, assignments can be copied, and student work can be completed by hand.
