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New Educational Programs

### 2230.2 NEW EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS

It shall be the policy of the Paterson Public School District that any new educational program that is to be developed and introduced to students must be at least 90% complete in all facets of its operation before students are introduced to the program. Those programs that fail to meet the 90% threshold, the administration must report their status to the Board.

A resolution to move forward, given the existing incomplete status, must be submitted to the Board of Education in order to implement the program. No program shall be implemented in absence of this approval, except where, in the case of state-controlled status, the State District Superintendent overrides the vote of the Board. In any case, no educational program should be implemented that is less than 80% completed in all facets of its operation.
