





- Prepares students for careers in the green economy, including in sustainable energy, agriculture, education, or field science






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Computer Science and Information Technology

- Prepare students for careers in network administration, software engineering, computer animation, multimedia production and programming




Engineering



- One Application for ALL SCHOOLS
- Application opens Friday, December 16th
- Application closes Friday, January 13th
- If you applied to Rosa Parks, International and /or Paterson P-Tech High Schools you will be contacted by the school to schedule a REQUIRED audition and/or interview.
- High School decisions will begin on March 31st and sent out by email.
- Students must respond by April 13th to confirm their acceptance and reserve their spot.
- Waitlist students will begin to be informed on April 14th. PATERSON PUBLIC SCHOOLS
